

2024 SPRING FIRE HYDRANT FLUSHING PROGRAM

The Matawan Department of Public Works will begin high-velocity flushing of the water distribution system through fire hydrants on Monday April 1, 2024. Department personnel will flow hydrants between 9:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M., Monday through Friday.

Periodically flushing the system helps to clean out accumulated sediment in the water mains and ensures that the hydrants are operational.

While the hydrants are flowing customers can expect temporary water pressure fluctuations and discoloration.

- Do not run water or use washing machines while fire hydrants are being opened in the area.
- Open a cold water faucet and make sure the water is clear before doing laundry.
- If water discoloration occurs, run the cold water faucet for a few minutes until it clears. In some cases, it may take a little longer.
- Water discoloration only affects the appearance of the water and not the quality. No health hazards are associated with discolored water resulting from fire hydrant flushing.
