November 3, 2020 General Election Voter Information

The 2020 General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020. Polls open at 6:00 AM and close at 8:00 PM.

Pursuant to Governor Murphy's Executive Order No. 177, the 2020 General Election is primarily a Vote-By-Mail (VBM) Election. All active registered voters will automatically receive VBM ballots for voting in the November 3, 2020 General Election. Voters have the option to vote early and cast their vote by use of a VBM ballot or to vote in-person on Election Day using a **Provisional Paper Ballot** at their designated polling locations. Only voters who are disabled or who need an accessible voting device to vote, and are registered as such with the County, will be permitted to vote on voting machines on Election Day. All other voters will be given **Provisional Paper Ballots**.

Voters have options by which to return their Vote By Mail Ballots:

1. VBM Ballots are filled out and mailed back to the County Clerk, and must be postmarked no later than Election Day, November 3, 2020.
2. Voters may also deliver their own completed VBM ballot in-person at their assigned polling location on November 3, 2020 by 8:00 PM but may not return any other voter's ballot at a polling location. You may also deliver it and submit your completed ballot to the Board of Elections Office, 300 Halls Mill Road, Freehold (732) 431-7802 ext. 7150 up until 8:00 PM on November 3, 2020. A voter delivering their own ballot is required to produce identification. Contact the Board of Elections at (732) 431-7802 ext. 7150 to find out what identification is acceptable.
3. There are limited drop box locations throughout the County for anyone who would rather drop off the ballot instead of mailing it. The closest one to Matawan is located at Aberdeen Town Hall, One Aberdeen Square, Aberdeen as well as the Hazlet NJ Motor Vehicle Commission Agency, 1374 Highway 36, Airport Plaza, Hazlet. 4. Voters may deliver their VBM ballots to their designated polling location.

There will be one (1) polling place open for all seven (7) of the Borough's voting districts located at Borough Hall, the Matawan Municipal Community Center, 201 Broad Street, Matawan. **All visitors will be required to wear a mask/face covering and adhere to posted social distancing guidelines.**
