The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

- Title: **Bond Ordinance 19-12:** Bond Ordinance Appropriating \$2,600,000 to Provide for Improvements to the Lake Lefferts Dam and Bridge MA-9 for the Borough of Matawan, Including a Grant in the Amount of \$500,000 Expected to be Received From the State of New Jersey and Authorizing the Issuance of \$2,100,000 Bonds or Notes to Finance Part of the Cost Thereof
- Purpose: To finance the Borough's portion of improvements for Lake Lefferts Dam and Bridge MA-9 pursuant to an interlocal agreement with the County of Monmouth.

Appropriation: \$2,600,000 Bonds/Notes Authorized: \$2,100,000 Grants Appropriated: \$500,000 Section 20 Expenses: \$260,000 Useful Life: 15 years
