Notice: Weather permitting, the pavement restoration on Sutphin Avenue near the intersection with County Route 516 will take place on Monday October 15, 2018.

If the work cannot proceed on the scheduled date due to weather, equipment problems or other causes, it will be rescheduled for the following workday.

The work primarily consists of the pavement restoration (mill and pave) of the affected area during the installation of the sanitary sewer force main. Due to the limited width of Sutphin Ave. the traffic will be limited to one lane during the milling operation; however, the road may require to be momentarily closed during the installation of the hot asphalt and open immediately once the material cools down to allow traffic. There will be Police Officers on site to assist in maintaining a safe traffic flow.

## This work will start after 8:00am once the school busses have left the area.

The Township of Aberdeen and the Contractor, Lucas Construction Group, Inc. will make every effort to minimize your inconvenience during construction. CME Associates, representing Aberdeen Township, will have a representative in the area while the work takes place.
