Notice: Weather permitting, the installation of trenchless sanitary sewer force main on Sutphin Ave. will start on or about July 23, 2018.

If the work cannot proceed on the scheduled dates due to weather, equipment problems or other causes, it will be rescheduled for the following workday.

The work primarily consists of the installation of the force main using a trenchless method, which will minimize the disturbance to the roadway and residents. The procedure requires the use of a special drill equipment, soil spoil container and mud separator. Due to the limited width of Sutphin Ave. the traffic will be limited to one lane during the day and it will be controlled by Police Officers to maintain a safe flow.

The Drilling equipment will be staged at the intersection of Sutphin Avenue and Rt 516. At the end of each work day the equipment will be moved to Shainy Lane during the off hours.

The Township of Aberdeen and the Contractor, Lucas Construction Group, Inc. will make every effort to minimize your inconvenience during construction.
