We are seeking a Field Technician to join our team for day-to-day coordination of streets, drainage, grounds.

The ideal candidate will live in town or within a 15-minute commute from Borough. They will be expected to have a sense of urgency and focus on meeting the expectations of the Borough. Duties could include the operation and maintenance of vehicles and/or machines, as needed in the Department of Public Works. The qualified candidate will be expected to perform routine work pertaining to the light construction, maintenance, repair and cleaning of streets, parks and playgrounds, public facilities, snow removal, leaf, brush, leaf/brush collection, and any other duties assigned.

Heavy manual labor in adverse weather conditions will be required. Knowledge with the experience and varieties of types of tools used in maintenance equipment preferred.

CDL License is preferred.
