# Minutes of the Unified Planning/Zoning Board of Adjustment August 5, 2019 7:00 PM

Mr. Strano, testified in support of himself, he states that he proposes to construct an  $8' \times 8'$  concrete pad for an above ground hot tub/spa. He advises the board that his application was denied by the Zoning Official because the proposed location of the spa, which is 43 feet from Lake Matawan, violates the Stream Setback Requirement Ordinance of a 100 ft setback.
