Public Notice of Adoption Ordinance 21-11

The ordinance published herewith has been finally adopted by the Borough of Matawan, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, by the recorded affirmative votes of at least two-thirds (2/3rds) of the full membership of the Governing Body at a meeting of the Governing Body held on July 20, 2021 at the Borough of Matawan, Municipal Community Center, 201 Broad Street, Matawan, New Jersey 07747. The twenty (20) day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such ordinance can be commenced has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement.

Copies of the full ordinance are available at no cost and during regular business hours at the Clerk's Office for the members of the general public who shall request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: Ordinance 21-11: Amending and Supplementing the Code of the Borough of Matawan Chapter 9 Personnel Policies, Article 2 Personnel Policies Concerning Members of the Police Department, Section 9-26 Promotions

Purpose: The Borough of Matawan desires to have a promotional practice for the positions of Police Chief, Lieutenant and Sergeant based upon merit, experience, education, demonstrated ability, competitive examinations, and competitive written submissions within the Matawan Police Department to better serve the residents of the Borough of Matawan. The Borough of Matawan further desires to establish appropriate hiring criteria based on merit, experience, moral character, and sufficient physical health when hiring police officers.
